Brief overview (500 words max)	 Sciences Po Lyon, also known as Institut d'Études Politiques de Lyon (Lyon Institute of Political Studies) is an undergraduate and graduate school of public affairs and international relations with a five-year degree that combines a Bachelor and a Masters. Entrance to the school is conditional upon passing a national competitive examination which is organized in common with five other Institutes of Political Studies, in Aix-en-Provence, Lille, Rennes, Strasbourg, Toulouse. Only the top 10% of the candidates are admitted. There are two other specific examinations to enter directly into year 2 or 4, in the latter case for a Masters program. Sciences Po Lyon has a total of approximately 1700 students over the five years of its curriculum. It also welcomes every year approximately 200 international students at both graduate and undergraduate levels. It also has an average of 12 international visiting faculty per year. Sciences Po Lyon has over 60 permanent faculty and over 200 part-time faculty and experts. A member of Université de Lyon, the Institute draws on its close ties with other schools and universities in the greater Lyon area to develop joint programs, together with research and teaching collaborations. The curriculum at Sciences Po Lyon is divided into three stages: In years 1 and 2, the students receive a multidisciplinary education in social sciences with an

Section 1. Basic Information

– Year 3 is, for the great majority of students, spent abroad, in one of our 150 partner
institutions. The year abroad is both an occasion to discover new teaching methods and
objects and to start identifying a specialization. A modest number of students combine one
semester abroad with a 4-to-6 month internship, either abroad, preferentially, or in France.
Fewer than 20 out of 240 spend their whole third year doing an internship.
- Upon their return to the Lyon campus, fourth-year students have a choice between three
streams : public affairs, international affairs and media/journalism. Most students complete
at the same time the Sciences Po degree, which is the equivalent of a Masters Degree, and a
national Masters Degree awarded by our partner universities or schools such as Université
Lyon 2 or Ecole Normale Supérieure de Lyon. Sciences Po Lyon aims at a high degree of
professionalization as a majority of our students enter the work market upon graduation. As a
result, most students spend the second semester of their 5th year doing an internship in the
public or private sector in France or abroad. At this point, the students have a wide range of
choices, from Public Policy and Comparative Government to Eastern Asian Studies.
Specialties also include Sustainable Development and Cooperation in Latin America,
Journalism, Urban Studies, Communication for International Cultural Organizations, European
Business and Institutions A significant number of students also prepare at the Institute the
national competitive examinations to enter the French or the European civil service systems,
a key element of the core mission of the Institute.
The quality and innovation of our programs is largely based on the faculty of Sciences Po Lyon
participating in highly ranked research teams that bring together scholars and scientists from a large
number of schools and universities that are part of the Université de Lyon. The Institute is also
supported financially by Région Rhône-Alpes, which greatly contributes to furthering and facilitating the
mobility of faculty, staff and students. Finally it draws on its close ties with the other five institutes of
political studies in France by encouraging mobility and mutualizing programs.
