Registration	Students will receive confirm of registration online and they will need to plan their study plan with the faculty with the signature of a Learning Agreement.
Additional Information	
Student Visa and Residence Permit	Students can enter the Country with a Student Visa. The Visa must be required at the Italian Consulate/Embassy of the resident country by applying at University website as student in mobility who wish to spend a period of study as Erasmus. Once in Italy, they have to apply for the residence permit through the Post office. They should take a residence permit kit and fill in all the forms. The ISMO and the Welcome Office orientate and help students for all the procedure during the 2 Welcome Weeks that will take place at the beginning of each semester.
Fiscal Code	We recommend the Student to require the Fiscal Code at the Italian Consulate in home country once they apply for the VISA; if it is not possible, once at Rome, he can go to <i>Agenzie delle Entrate</i> and ask for <i>Codice Fiscale</i> . The nearest Agenzia is in via di Torrespaccata 110
