NOMINATION & APPLICATION



Semester dates

Fall 2025: September 1, 2025 – December 30, 2025

Spring 2026: January 9, 2026 – June 30, 2026

Nomination

Fall 2025 (second half of year) – May 15, 2025

Spring 2026 (first half of year) – November 10, 2025

Official nominations should be submitted through our <u>Online Nomination form</u> by the coordinator of a partner university. Every nomination should be submitted separately.

NOTE:

- 1. A nominated student must be at least 18 years old;
- 2. A nominated student's passport must be valid for at least 18 months from the proposed start date of the visa (1-3 days' difference is allowed):

Fall 2025 - March 1, 2027

Spring 2026 - July 5, 2027

Otherwise, the student may be required to apply for a new passport.

Application

Fall 2025 (second half of year) - May 30, 2025

Spring 2026 (first half of year) – November 20, 2025

After being nominated, students will receive a welcome letter from <u>international.study@hse.ru</u> with an invitation to fill out an online student account and attach scans of the following documents:

- 1. Consent for processing of personal data;
- 2. Passport (valid for at least 18 months from the start date of the planned visa);
- 3. University/college transcript/records of current studies (in English);
- 4. Motivation letter (300-500 words/in English);
- 5. Photo (3x4 cm, passport format).

After all documents are submitted, students will receive HSE University Letter of Acceptance and Invitation Letter issued by the Migration Authority (if applicable).

Acceptance on courses depends on whether a student meets course prerequisites and there are free places. Acceptance to certain courses may be subject to the relevant department's approval.

We highly recommend Undergraduate students to only choose from Undergraduate level courses. Courses of the following programmes/faculties are **NOT** available for exchange students:

- → Master of International Business
- ⇒ International Relations and Global Studies
- ⇒ HSE University and Kyung Hee University Double Degree Programme in Economics and Politics in Asia
- ⇒ Faculty of Urban and Regional Development

Courses belonging to the following faculties are available in **RUSSIAN** only:

Recommended language level

For courses taught in English – no less than an English level of B2 (TOEFL iBT 75/IELTS 6.5).

For courses taught in Russian – no less than a Russian level C1 (based on the <u>Common European Framework of Reference for Languages</u> levels)

No certificate confirming current language level is required.

Russian as a Foreign Language (optional) – 72 classes per semester (6 credits). Levels: from beginner to advanced.

1 credit = 38 academic hours = 25,3 astronomical hours

DOCUMENTS



Visa support HSE University provides visa support for international students. A visa invitation is required to obtain a student visa. Visa invitations are ordered through the Russian Ministry of Internal Affairs for every student. It takes around 45 days for an invitation to be issued. The first visa issued is a single-entry visa valid for 90 days. Then it is extended to a multiple-entry visa valid for of the entire period of the student's exchange.

NOTE: Be prepared to stay in Russia without leaving for a 90-day period after your initial arrival until you receive your multiple-entry visa.

Obligatory procedures

Foreign students arriving in Russia for a period of more than 90 days must undergo medical examination, fingerprinting and official photographing.

Students need a passport translation certified by a Russian notary to undergo the procedures.
