Limited Chinese Language courses at ICES and non-credit Chinese language training classes might be available in this program, but there is NO guarantee that they will be available every semester. Registered Chinese Language courses at ICES will appear on your official transcript, but non-credit Chinese language	

training classes will NOT.

Undergraduate-level courses in basic medical sciences, clinical medicine, and nursing are not available.
