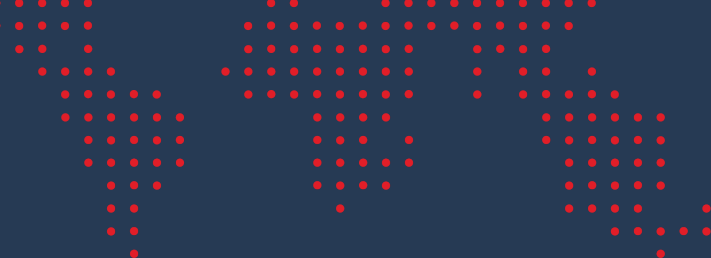

¹ If at least one subject is accepted by the course coordinator(s), the student will receive the Letter of Acceptance to apply for the visa by email. According to new Brazilian regulations, the minimum working hours to be completed by exchange students must be fifteen/15 hours per week. Therefore, we suggest that all students recommended by their home universities choose as many subjects as possible, among those that interest them, so that they can be accepted in three or four of them, in order to obtain the minimum course load required by Brazilian legislation.



Student Nomination and Application	
Nomination - procedures	Students must be nominated by their home institution at nomination forms (Starting from September 15th, 2025).
Application - procedures	Students must also register online on the DAC (Academic Board) website, in the SIGA .
Language Requirements	Unicamp does not have knowledge requirements in Portuguese. All Undergraduate level classes and most Postgraduate classes are offered in Portuguese. Exchange students are offered Portuguese classes in English and Spanish.
Areas with Restrictions	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Medicine: Only observational internships with a maximum duration of 90 days are allowed. Theoretical or practical courses do not accept enrollment of foreign students. For further information, please visit: https://www.fcm.unicamp.br/fcm/international-office • Music: Only for music course students, especially instrument classes. • Art courses: Only for art students. • Sports Courses: For sports course students only. • Thesis and final projects: most departments do not accept students for theses and final projects, even though no exams are required. • Language courses: Only Portuguese for foreigners or Portuguese for Spanish speakers, and ONLY if the student takes the placement test before the start of classes.

Credits / Hours	<p>Undergraduate and Graduate students from Partner Universities can enroll for up to 32 credits per semester.</p> <p>At UNICAMP, each credit corresponds to 15 class hours, lasting 15 (fifteen) weeks of class activities (readings, laboratory, etc).</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • There is no official equivalency between Credits at UNICAMP and ECTS. • ALL EXCHANGE STUDENTS must have at least 15 hours (15 credits) due to a federal police legislation for regularizing the visa.
Visa	<p>To enroll at UNICAMP, a Student or Mercosur Visa is required. More info at Info Sheet</p>
Health Insurance	<p>Health insurance is mandatory for all foreign students, and a copy of this document must be delivered to DAC via the system. The insurance must cover medical and repatriation expenses from the day the student leaves the country of origin.</p>
