6. ACCOMMODATION

- The monthly dormitory fee is 40,000 tenge (approximately 70 USD).
- Upon check-in, students will receive bed linen, a pillow, and a blanket.
- Additionally, the university provides a free airport transfer to the dormitory.

7. VISA

All persons arriving to Republic of Kazakhstan must have an international passport, the validity must not expire earlier than 3 months from the date of expiration of the visa and must be at least 2 blank pages intended for obtaining visas and stamps.

International students must receive C9 type visa before their arrival to Republic of Kazakhstan. Student should apply for a visa at the Kazakhstani embassy or consular office in home country.

8. BUDDY PROGRAM

MNU has a 'Buddy' program, where an MNU student is assigned to an international student to assist them upon arrival and throughout their stay in the city. The Buddy is always concerned about the student's well-being and is ready to answer questions and help with any issues throughout the entire exchange semester.

9. ORIENTATION

Before the courses begin, an orientation week will be organised by the Department of Student Affairs.

The program of the orientation week includes activities, events and trips which will be held at the beginning of the semester to introduce the university and its activities, as well as Kazakh national peculiarities to international students. It is an amazing opportunity for exchange students to get acquainted with the Kazakhstani educational system and to adapt to a new cultural atmosphere before the start of the academic semester and educational process.
