Chinese-taught Content Courses

Exchange students could take Chinese-taught Content courses with the permission from course instructors.

Credits:

- (1) Exchange students can get formal NJU credits as long as they finish the required class attendance and pass exams. One credit equals to 16 hours of study.
- (2) Exchange students are required to take **8-25 credits** every semester.
