## SDU AT A GLANCE

Founded in 1901, Shandong University (SDU) is a key comprehensive university selected in China's "Double First-Class" Initiative with a long and honorable history. With campuses in Jinan, Qingdao, and Weihai, it is in the region where Chinese philosopher Confucius was born.

As a comprehensive university, it offers doctoral, master's, and bachelor's degree programs in almost all disciplines, including liberal arts, social sciences, science, engineering, and medicine. It is especially well-known for Chinese classical studies, financial mathematics, reproductive medicine, underground engineering, crystal materials, etc.

Shandong University partners with more than 300 institutions from over 45 countries and regions, such as Yale University, the University of Melbourne, Nanyang Technological University, Korea University and the University of Nottingham, etc.

## Language of Instruction

## Course Load

3 to 5 courses per semester (2 or 3 credits per course)

The minimum study load is 1 postgraduate course or carrying out research with the consent of an SDU supervisor.

## Transcript

- Official transcripts are usually issued in late March for the fall semester and late September for the spring semester.
- Department of International Affairs will post official English and Chinese transcripts to the home universities.

# APPLICATION

## Number of Exchange Students

- Per the student exchange agreement between the two universities.
- Exchange programs are open to undergraduates and graduate students.

## Exchange Period

- One or two semesters
- Enrollment is possible in the spring semester or fall semester

## Entry Requirement

There is no requirement for studying Chinese language.

For academic courses, students must meet the following requirements:

**1. GPA:** 70/100, 2.3/4.0

### 2. Year of Study

- For undergraduate students, applicants should have completed the equivalent of at least one year of full-time study in the program in which they are enrolled at their home university.
- For graduate students, applicants should have completed at least the first semester of the master's or doctoral program in which they are enrolled at their home university.

**3. Applicants must be enrolled as regular students in a partner university and not have graduated from their home universities before completing the mobility period at SDU.**

### 4. Language proficiency

- Chinese-taught academic courses

HSK 5 (180 points and above). Non-native Chinese speakers must provide valid and acceptable Chinese proficiency proof.

- English-taught academic courses

No proof of English proficiency is required, but students are strongly recommended to reach TOEFL iBT 80/IELTS 6.

## Nomination

Nomination Form will be shared with partner universities in March and September.

Deadline: **May 20** for Fall semester, **November 20** for Spring semester

## Application Period

Exchange students should apply through the SDU online application system.

- Fall semester: March 1 to May 30
- Spring semester: September 1 to November 30



## Online Application

Online application portal: <http://www.apply.sdu.edu.cn>.

1. Create an account: click “Register” to register with your email and nationality.

2. Activate the account.

3. Log into the application system. Select “Exchange Students” and you will see a list of programs. Based on your intended study duration and instruction language, choose the one that suits you most, and then start the application.

Notes:

All the exchange programs in the application system are listed under the College of International Education. The Admission Office will forward the applicants' materials to a relevant school/college according to the information in the nomination form, transcript, and study plan for further approval.

4. Fill in the application form.

5. Upload the following documents:

- Passport-sized photo
- Information page of your passport (including photo, name, date of birth, place of birth, country of citizenship)
- Official up-to-date transcripts in English/Chinese issued by your home university
- Nomination letter from the International Office in English/Chinese
- Personal statement including study plan in English/Chinese
- Physical Examination Record for Foreigner
- Proof of language proficiency (if applicable)



# NOTIFICATION OF APPLICATION RESULTS

- **Fall Semester:** mid-to-late June
- **Spring Semester:** mid-to-late December

## ACCOMMODATION

We strongly encourage students to live on campus. However, if students do wish to stay off-campus, they can rent a room with the consent of the host school/college.

## COST

### Tuition Fee

The tuition fee of Shandong University will be waived for exchange students conforming with the exchange agreements. Students shall pay tuition fees to their home university.

### Accommodation

1,200 – 1,500 RMB per month

### Living Cost

1,000 – 2,000 RMB per month, depending on individual lifestyle





## VISA & RESIDENCE PERMIT

- Admitted students must apply for a study visa at the Chinese Embassy/Consulate in their countries of residence with the Admission Notice and JW201/JW202/DQ Form.
- International students who will study in China for less than 6 months should apply for the X2 Visa.
- International students who will study in China for more than 6 months are required to obtain the X1 visa.
- To stay in China legally, it is mandatory for X1 holders to apply for the Residence Permit within 30 days of arrival in China.

## MEDICAL INSURANCE

- According to the regulations of the Chinese Ministry of Education, international students coming to China must purchase medical insurance in Chinese mainland.
- The medical insurance fee is 400 RMB/semester/person.
- Students who have not purchased medical insurance will not be registered. Please log in to <http://www.lxbx.net> for insurance content and claims procedures.
