NOMINATION PROCESS

At the beginning of the process, application coordinators from partner universities can nominate students by sending a table with student information to the email addresses of the International Office and the Exchange Programs Coordinator at the Center for International Programs and Mobility. The table should include the student's first name, last name, date of birth, major, and year of study.

APPLICATION PROCESS

After the nomination, students receive an email with information regarding the application..

Students' applications are submitted by completing a Google Form. At the end of the application form, students are required to upload the necessary documents.

The list of documents to be uploaded includes:

- Passport
- Transcript
- Photo
- Visa support form (for students who need to apply for a visa)

ACCOMMODATION IN ALMATY

Dormitory

Students have the option to stay in a dormitory. ALMAU cooperates with a dormitory in the city. Since the university does not have its own dormitory, availability may be limited. The dormitory is located in the city center and offers 2–3 person rooms.

VISA PROCESS



The Center for International Programs and Mobility has a manager responsible for migration and visa matters. The student needs to attach a passport (valid for at least 12 months after finishing the exchange period) and a visa support form to the application. After that, the manager handles the visa processing for Kazakhstan. The student must then go to the Kazakhstan embassy in their country to collect the issued visa.

COST OF LIVING



Almaty is generally cheaper than many Western cities, but it is one of the most expensive cities in Kazakhstan.

Housing:

- Rent for a 1-bedroom apartment in the city centre typically ranges around \$550–\$700 per month, and lower outside the centre.

Food & Groceries:

- Eating out at an inexpensive restaurant costs around \$6–\$7.

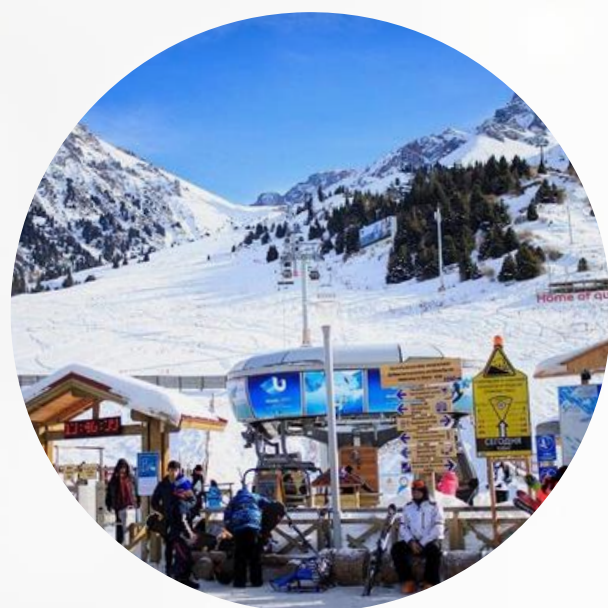
Transport:

- Public transport (bus, tram, metro) is cheap, and monthly passes are inexpensive (120 tenge = 0.24 USD).

Monthly Budget Example:

- A single person's basic monthly expenses (rent, food, transport) can average around \$800–\$1,200 depending on lifestyle.





SIGHTSEEING IN ALMATY

Big Almaty Lake

A stunning natural alpine lake located about 15 km south of Almaty. Known for its turquoise water and scenic mountain views, it's a popular spot for hiking and photography.

Shymbulak

A ski resort in the Zailiyskiy Alatau mountains, offering skiing, snowboarding, and hiking. Open year-round, it has cable cars and beautiful panoramic views.

Kok Tobe

A hill in Almaty with an observation tower, amusement park, and restaurants. Famous for panoramic city views and the iconic TV tower.

Medeu

The world's highest ice skating rink, located in the mountains near Almaty. A popular spot for skating, sports events, and mountain walks.

Charyn Canyon

A natural wonder about 200 km east of Almaty, featuring dramatic rock formations and the "Valley of Castles." Ideal for hiking, photography, and nature trips.
