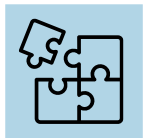

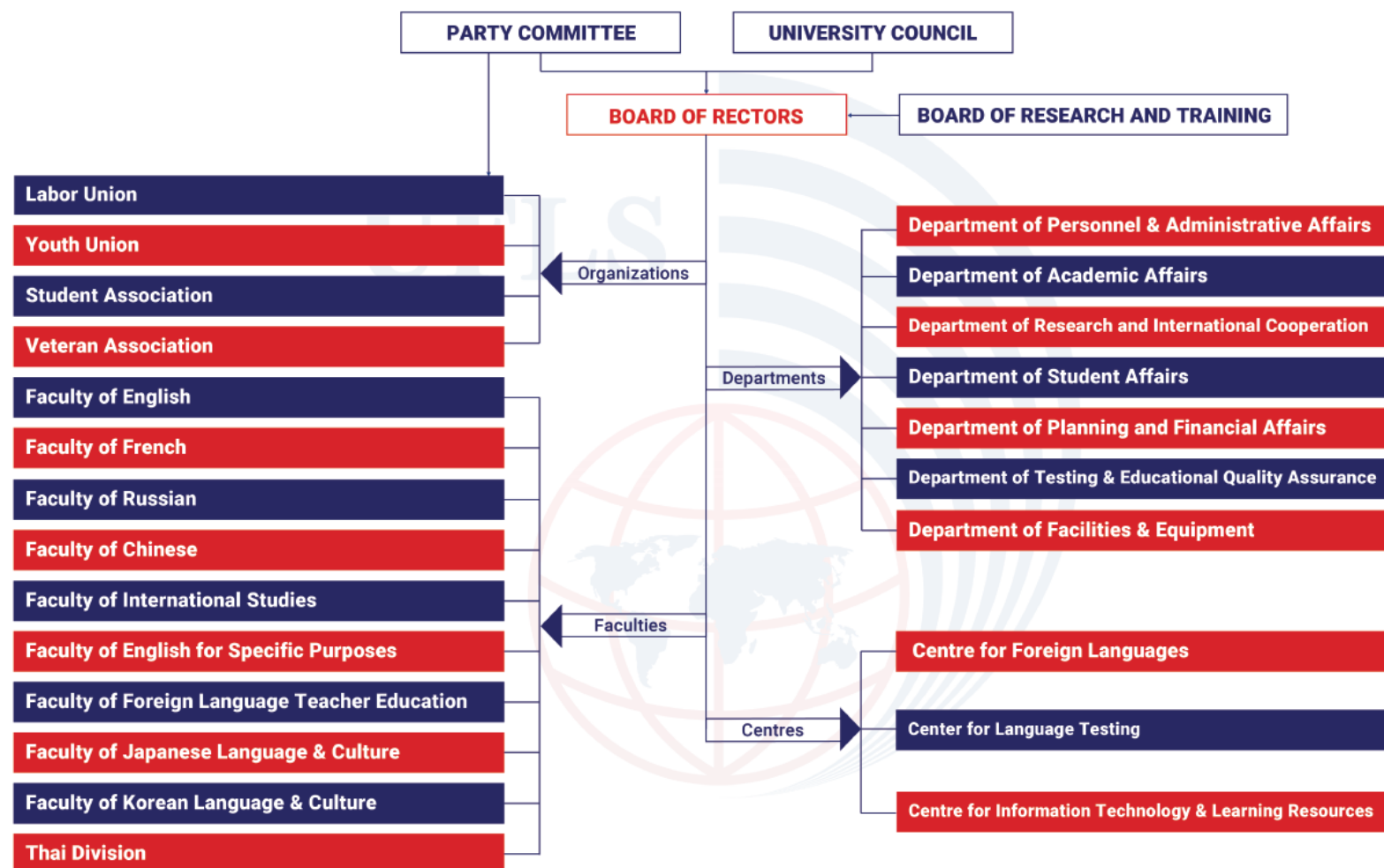

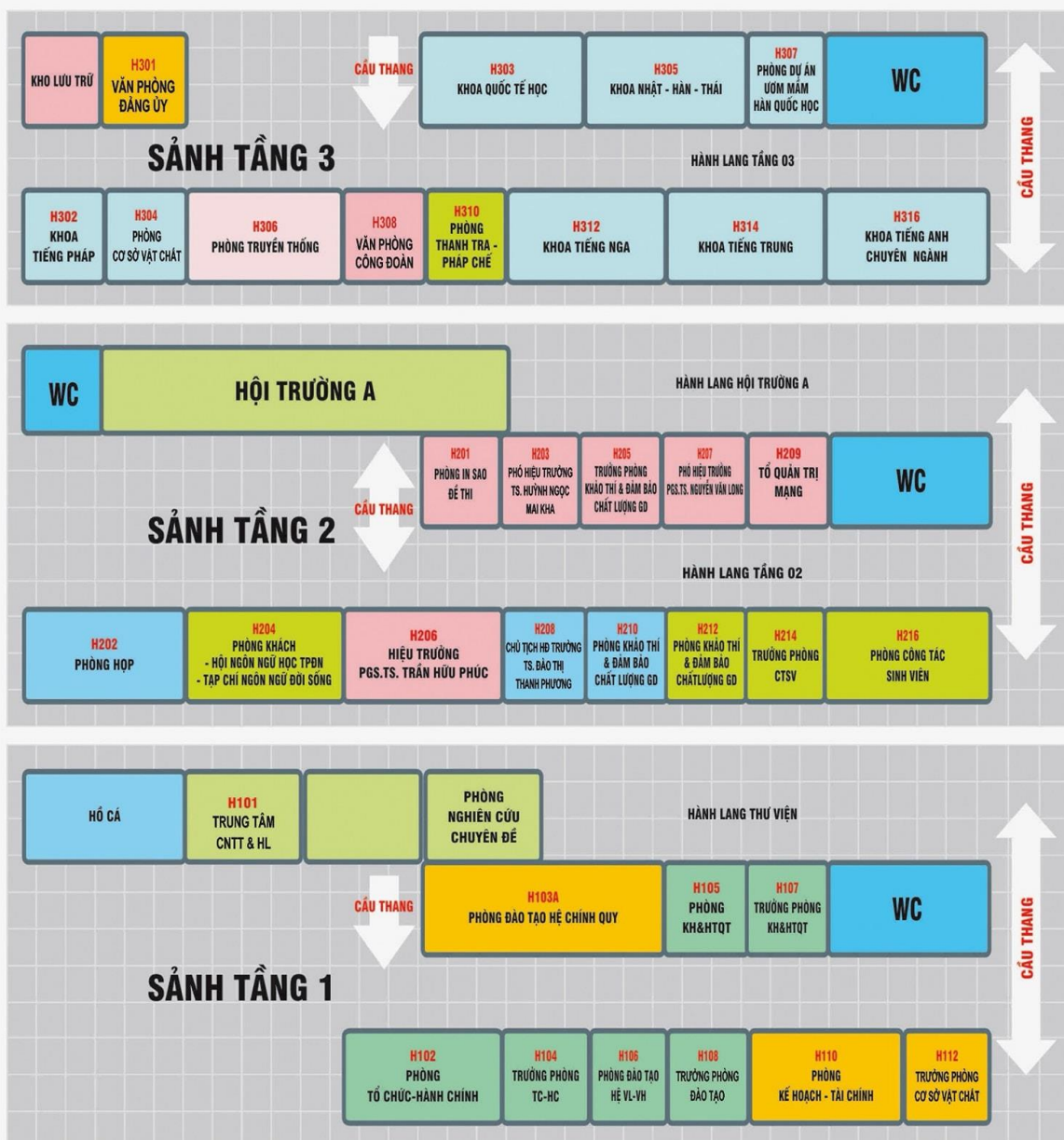


ORGANIZATIONAL STRUCTURE

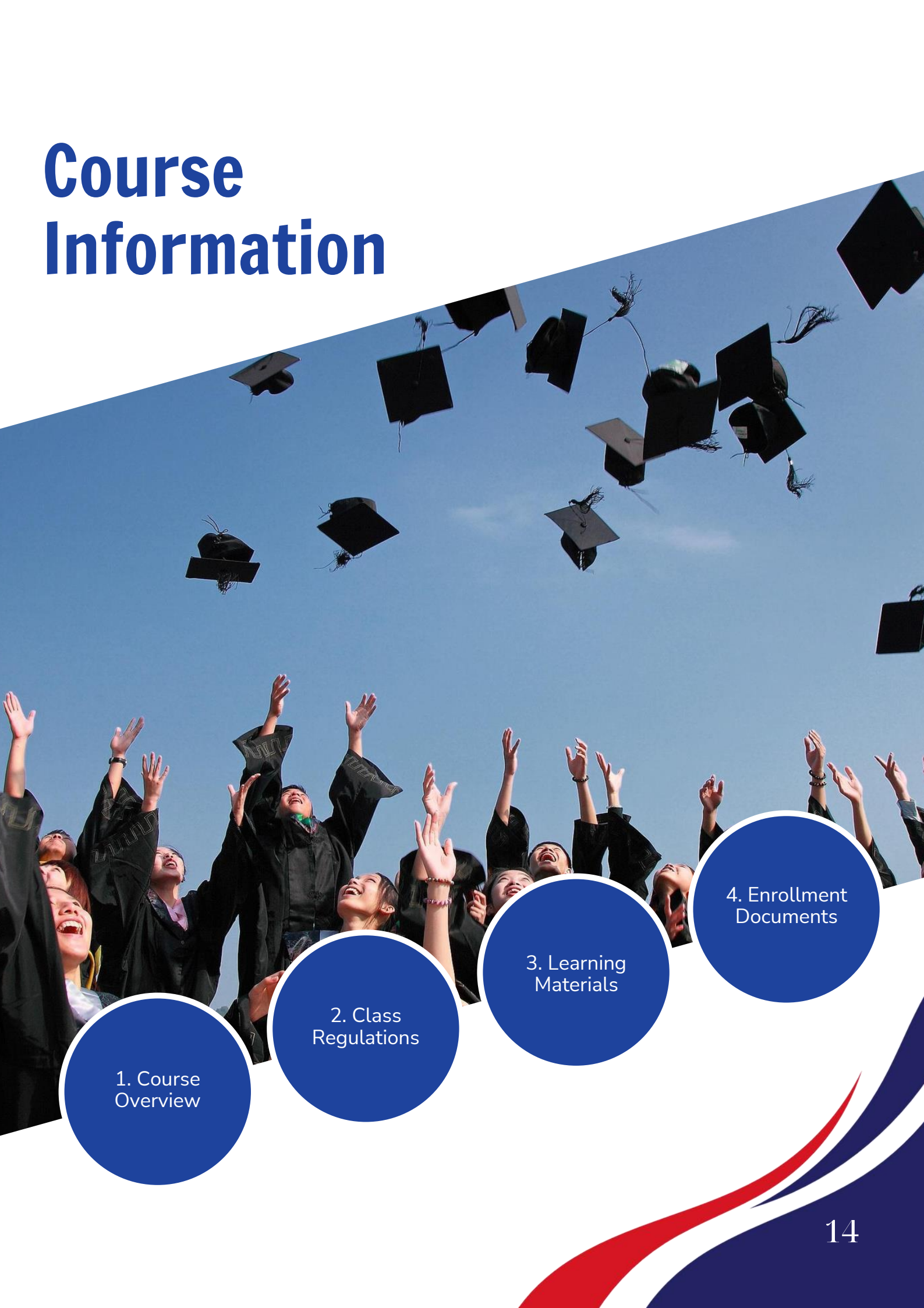

Geography, Climate and People

Da Nang City is located in Central Viet Nam, bordered by Thua Thien Hue Province to the north, Quang Ngai Province to the south, and the East Sea to the east.

It covers an area of 11,859.59 km², with a population of about 3,065,628 people. Administratively, the city consists of 94 commune-level units, including 23 wards, 70 communes, and 1 special administrative unit (Hoang Sa District).

Da Nang City has a tropical climate with two distinct seasons: the rainy season (from around September to December) and the dry season (from January to August).

The average annual temperature ranges from 27°C to 29°C (the hottest months are from June to August, reaching up to 37-38°C). The city is usually affected by typhoons in September and October each year.

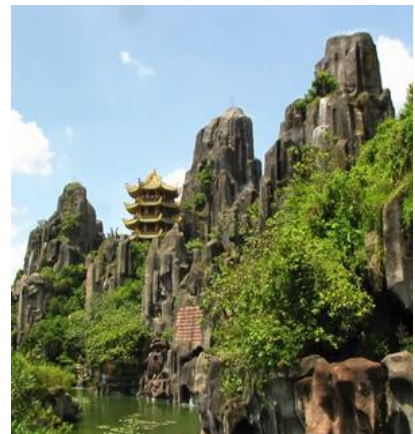

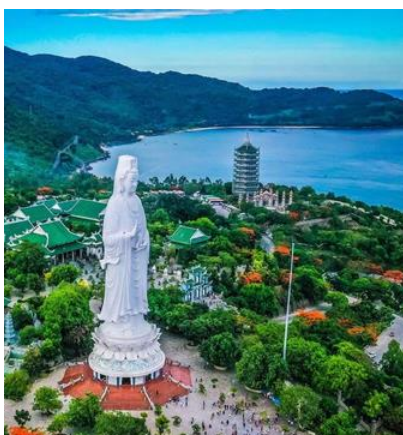

BASIC VIETNAMESE CULTURE AND CUSTOMS

- ◆ Distinctive features in communication and behavior

GREETING

- **Bowing:** A sign of respect, especially toward elders or those of higher status. The degree of the bow depends on the relationship and context
- **Handshake:** Common, but often accompanied by a slight nod, particularly when greeting older people
- **Forms of address:** Use appropriate pronouns based on age and relationship: *anh/chị* (for someone a bit older), *cô/chú/bác* (for older adults), *ông/bà* (for the elderly). With friends or younger people, *bạn/em* can be used
- Add the given name after the pronoun (e.g., *chị Lan*, *anh Nam*)
- Avoid using “tôi” or addressing older people as “bạn”
- **Smiling:** Often used to express friendliness and openness



IN COMMUNICATION

- **Maintaining harmony:** Vietnamese people value harmony and tend to avoid direct conflict
- **Showing modesty:** Avoid boasting about oneself
- **Indirect communication:** Sometimes, Vietnamese people may express their intentions indirectly to avoid offending others. It is important to pay attention to context and body language

IN BEHAVIOR

- **Strong sense of community:** Family, friends, and the collective are highly valued. Helping and sharing are appreciated
- **Respect for the elderly:** Demonstrated through speech, actions, and manners
- **Hospitality:** Vietnamese people are often warm and welcoming, especially when receiving guests at home.



2. MAJOR FESTIVALS AND RELATED CUSTOMS

A festival to honor the Hung Kings and those who contributed to the founding of the nation
- 04** | Independence Day (September 2, Gregorian calendar)
Celebrating the day Viet Nam declared independence
- 05** | Other holidays

Lunar New Year

◆ Lunar New Year (Tết Nguyên Đán), also known as the Traditional New Year, is the most important festival in Vietnamese culture. It marks the transition from the old year to the new year and usually takes place in late January or early February (Gregorian calendar).

◆ Traditional customs during Lunar New Year in Vietnam include:

- Visiting ancestors' graves
- Cleaning and decorating the house to welcome the New Year
- Making *bánh chưng* and *bánh tét* (traditional sticky rice cakes)
- Offering rituals to the Kitchen Gods (*ông Công, ông Táo*)
- Displaying flowers and arranging a five-fruit tray (*mâm ngũ quả*)
- Holding a Year-End gathering (*Tất niên*)
- New Year's Eve celebration (*Giao thừa*)
- First visitor of the year (*xông đất*)
- New Year's greetings and giving lucky money (*lì xì*)



MID-AUTUMN FESTIVAL

◆ The Mid-Autumn Festival, celebrated on the 15th day of the 8th lunar month each year, is known as the Children's Festival and is also called the "Moon-Watching Festival"

◆ Traditional customs of the Mid-Autumn Festival in Viet Nam include:

- Lantern parade: Colorful lanterns of various shapes are an indispensable symbol of the festival.
- Moon feast (*phá cỗ*): Enjoying the festive tray of mooncakes, candies, fruits, baked cakes, and sticky rice cakes.
- Lion dance (*múa lân*): The lion dance featuring the trio of mythical creatures (Lion – Unicorn – Dragon) symbolizes prosperity and good fortune during the festival..



Hung Kings' Commemoration Day

◆ Hung Kings' Commemoration Day (the 10th day of the 3rd lunar month) is an important Vietnamese festival held to honor the Hung Kings for their contributions to the founding of the nation.

◆ Highlighted activities during the festival include:

- Offering incense: People from across the country make a pilgrimage to the Hung Temple (Phu Tho Province) to offer incense in remembrance of the Hung Kings.
- Cultural events: Various cultural, artistic, sporting activities, and traditional folk games are organized.



Independence Day

◆ Viet Nam Independence Day is a national holiday celebrated on September 2 each year, commemorating the day President Ho Chi Minh proclaimed the Declaration of Independence at Ba Dinh Square, Ha Noi, establishing the Democratic Republic of Viet Nam, now the Socialist Republic of Viet Nam.

◆ Celebratory activities include military parades and processions, fireworks displays (depending on locality), cultural, artistic, and sporting events.



OTHER HOLIDAYS



New Year's Day (January 1, Gregorian calendar): Celebrating the beginning of the solar new year.



Reunification Day (April 30, Gregorian calendar): Marking the liberation of the South and national reunification.



International Workers' Day (May 1, Gregorian calendar).



Vietnamese Teachers' Day (November 20, Gregorian calendar): Honoring teachers.



International Women's Day (March 8, Gregorian calendar): Honoring women.

3. DOS AND DON'TS TO SHOW CULTURAL RESPECT

✓ Dos

- Take the initiative to learn about Vietnamese culture and customs.
- Pay attention to how Vietnamese people communicate and behave.
- Show respect to elders: greet politely and use appropriate language.
- Enjoy the local culinary culture.
- Participate in cultural activities: a great opportunity to integrate and better understand Vietnamese culture.
- Dress modestly, especially when visiting sacred places such as pagodas, temples, and churches.
- Be polite in public: keep order and avoid making noise.
- Ask for advice when uncertain: if you are unsure about a custom, don't hesitate to ask local people.

✗ Don'ts

- Point at others, especially elders.
- Discuss or criticize political or religious issues in an insensitive manner.
- Wear revealing or inappropriate clothing in public and sacred places.
- Be noisy or disruptive in quiet places.
- Stick chopsticks upright in a bowl of rice: this resembles offerings to the deceased. Instead, place them across the bowl or on a chopstick rest.
