



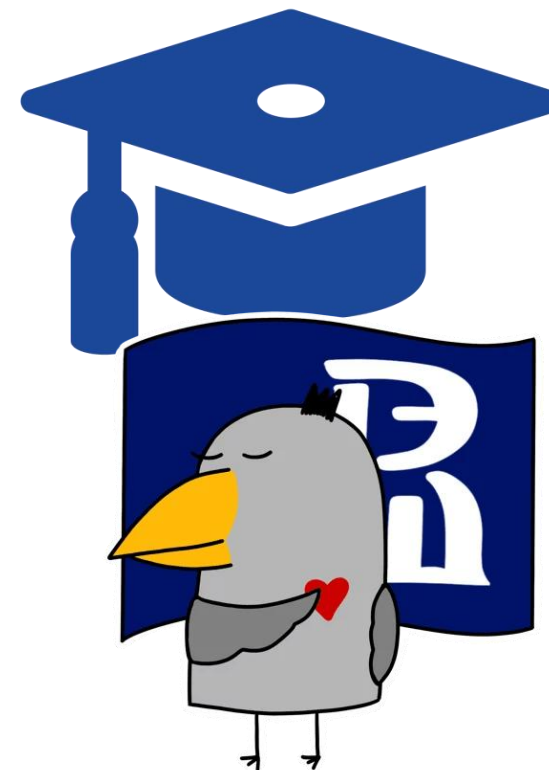

- 1. Use your HSE e-mail address (...@edu.hse.ru)**
- 2. Avoid leaving the Subject line empty**
- 3. Mention your full name**
- 4. Introduce yourself as an exchange student**
- 5. Give enough details, e.g. mention the name of the course you are asking about**
- 6. Give your attachment a meaningful name**

How will I take exams?

- **If there is more than one exam scheduled on the same day, submit a request to reschedule one of the exams no later than three days before the start of the exam period.**
- **Retake period for Fall courses: in February**

Academic Integrity and the use of Artificial Intelligence

- **Instructors may prohibit the use of generative models during assessments by explicitly stating this restriction in the course syllabus.**

Plagiarism

Plagiarism refers to the appropriation of another person's text or any other intellectual property (copyright) published in hard copy or electronically:

- **without providing the author's name and the source of borrowed materials**
- **when a reference is provided, yet the nature and scope of the borrowings cast doubt as to whether the paper, or one of its main sections, has been written by the student on an independent basis.**

Three types of plagiarism

- 1. repeating another person's text word-for-word**
- 2. fully using any other intellectual property item**
- 3. paraphrasing another person's text with different words and expressions, yet without changing the overall contents of the borrowed text**
