### Health Insurance

Health insurance is obligatory in Switzerland. Students can apply for an exemption from Swiss health insurance if their home health insurance confirms that they offer the same coverage as a Swiss health insurance and agree to cover all possible costs. If the student's home health insurance provider refuses to sign the required document, a Swiss health insurance, e.g. Swisscare needs to be purchased.
