Academic Calendar

For Spring Semester: from mid February to late June/early July
For Fall Semester: from early/mid September to mid/late January

Application Deadlines

For Spring Semester: November 15th
For Fall Semester: May 15th
*It is kindly suggested to submit applications two weeks prior to the deadlines.

Language Proficiency

For degree programs taught in Chinese: HSK 5 in general
For English-taught courses: IELTS 6 in general (The exact requirement varies somewhat from one exchange agreement to another. Please check it with the International Mobility Coordinators prior to the application.)

Transcripts

For a one-semester exchange, the transcript will be mailed to the coordinator at home university at the end of the semester. For a full-academic-year exchange, the transcripts will be sent separately each semester.

Application Checklist

- Application form
- A certifying letter (for confirmation of the status as a registered student of home university)
- Official transcripts from home university about courses attended
- Copy of IELTS/HSK test score
- A personal statement (in Chinese or English no less than 800 words)
- A recommendation letter
- Certificate of health
- Legible copy of passport

Visa

Visa Application for Study in China (Form JW 202) and the Admission Notice are supporting documents for visa procedures at the Chinese Embassy in relevant countries.

Airport Pick-up & Orientation

For each semester, one airport pick-up, free of charge, is arranged by Global Education Center. The exact date, normally the weekend before the orientation week, will be announced before the semester starts.

It is highly suggested that students attentively participate in the orientation, which consists of registration, regulation acknowledgement, campus tour, placement test and other related activities.

Accommodation

Online application suffices. No paper copy is needed. Placements are offered on a first-come, first-served basis. It is highly suggested to apply within two weeks upon the online system's availability as the followings:

- For Spring Semester: late November
- For Fall Semester: late May
