

Application procedure

- Nomination deadline (Online Application) *subject to change
 - Spring semester(Feb to Jun): **10th October** / Fall semester(Sep to Dec): **24th April**
- Application deadline (Online Application) *subject to change
 - Spring semester(Feb to Jun): **17nd October** / Fall semester(Sep to Dec): **8th May**

■ Application documents

- 1st: A copy of passport, Study Plan, Recommendation Letter, Official transcript
- ※ Additional documents(only students from None OECD countries): A certificate of bank statement(balance) / A certificate of enrollment of current home university notarized by the Korea embassy or Apostilled.
- 2nd: Health clearance(TB test Result), Flight info, Copy of Korea visa

Language requirement

SEOULTECH requires a good knowledge of English(B2 level) or Korean(TOPIK3 level) to communicate and function in an academic context. * No need to submit a certification.

Insurance

International students staying in Korea are subject to a mandatory subscription to National health insurance. No need to apply and all students will be automatically registered after their arrival.

Visa

SeoulTech international office will send the Letter of Acceptance, which is necessary for the Student Visa (D-2).
