GPA Requirement	Applicants must have completed two semesters at an AIU partner institution <b>before applying</b> and have a cumulative GPA (Grade Point Average) of <b>2.50 (4.0 scale) or higher</b> .
Level of English Proficiency Requirement	Applicants whose first language is NOT English are required to achieve a standard of TOEFL ® Test score 71 (iBT), IELTS score of 6.0 or an equivalent of either test score.
