It is important to mention that the Faculty of Medicine at UFMG will undergo changes in the curriculum at the beginning of 2023 (as required by the Ministry of Education). Therefore, it will take requests for mobility exchange for the next year and each case will be analyzed by the course Collegiate, as there are subjects that will undergo changes, but the syllabus have not yet been defined.
